difference	the quality or state being different
famous	very well known
King/Queen	a male/female ruler of a country who inherits their position
rule	a guide or principle for conduct or action

SUBJECT SPECIFIC VOCAULARY	
Crimean War	a military conflict fought from October 1853 to February 1856
nurse	a person skilled or trained in caring for the sick and in maintaining good health in those who are not sick and who works either independently or under the supervision of a physician
Order of Merit	an award presented by the reigning king or queen for exceptional service to the armed forces, science, art, literature, or for the promotion of culture.
hospital	a place where the sick or injured are given medical or surgical care
