Know that heavily amplified guitars, bass guitars, drums and key board sounds are style indicators of classic rock music.

Know that Rock Music has developed over 1950-1980s.

Know that fortissimo means to play music very loud for effect.

Know that by the end of the 20th century, rock music was the most dominant form of pop music.

MUSICAL VOCABULARY

cover	a version of a song performed by someone other than the original artist. It might sound a bit or very different from the original.
dimensions of music	musical dimensions identify the ways in which any sound can be described and the ways in which each dimension can be changed to create different musical effects
synthesizer	an electronic instruments, typically controlled by a keyboard. Commonly used in rock music.
melody	another name for tune
producer	a record producer or music producer oversees and manages the sound recording and production of a band or performer's music.
style indicators	identifiers that show us the genre of the music.
