

What are we talking about this half term?


We are learning to talk about ourselves; what we look like, what we enjoy playing with, our homes and families.

Communication and Language



At Nursery we begin to 'listen and do' at the same time. We enjoy listening to and singing a large repertoire of songs. We learn how to start conversations with an adult or a friend and continue it for many turns.

Physical Development


