
Happy New Year!




We enjoy the celebration of Chinese New Year.

Communication and Language

We use talk to help work out problems and organise thinking and activities, and to explain how things work and why they might happen.

Our weekly PE sessions will involve developing and refining a range of ball skills including throwing, catching, kicking, passing, batting, and aiming.

Literacy

We review and continue to use all our single letter and special friend

RWI sounds.


We hold a simple sentence in our

We discuss the name of the road and town our school is located in. We look at aerial views of our school setting and draw simple maps of our immediate environment and maps from imaginary story settings we are familiar with.
