



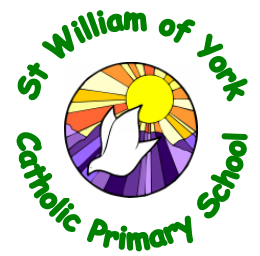

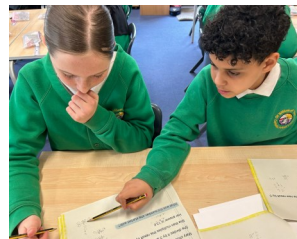


Bank Holiday Monday
