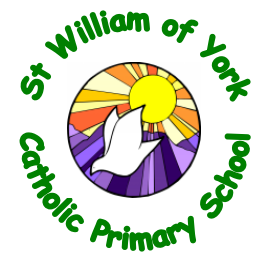

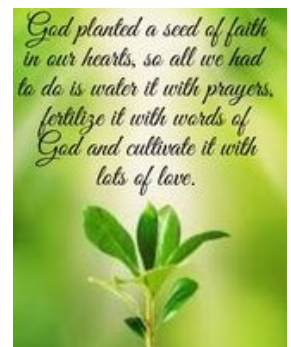
REMINDER
