- Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

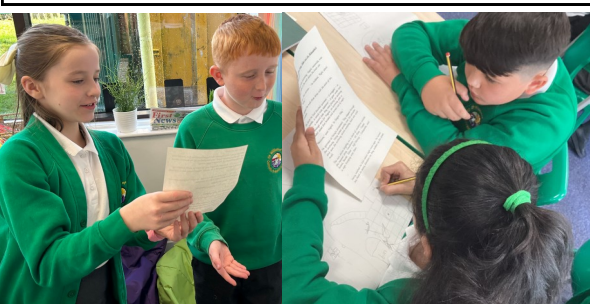
If you think you may be eligible, please see Mrs Mohammad or Miss Adams, who will support you in applying.
