We will send the report as soon as it is published!

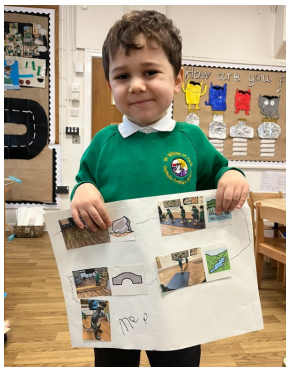
