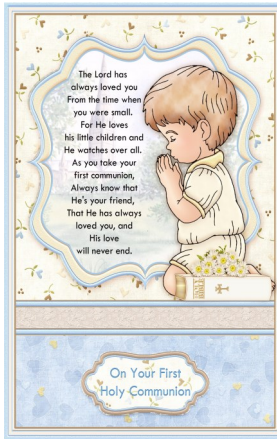
Year 6 Design and Technology Project
