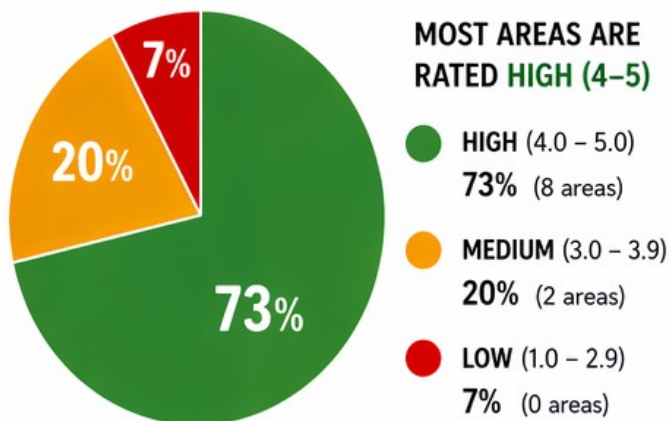

More opportunities to be involved, clearer communication and more support for parents' own learning.



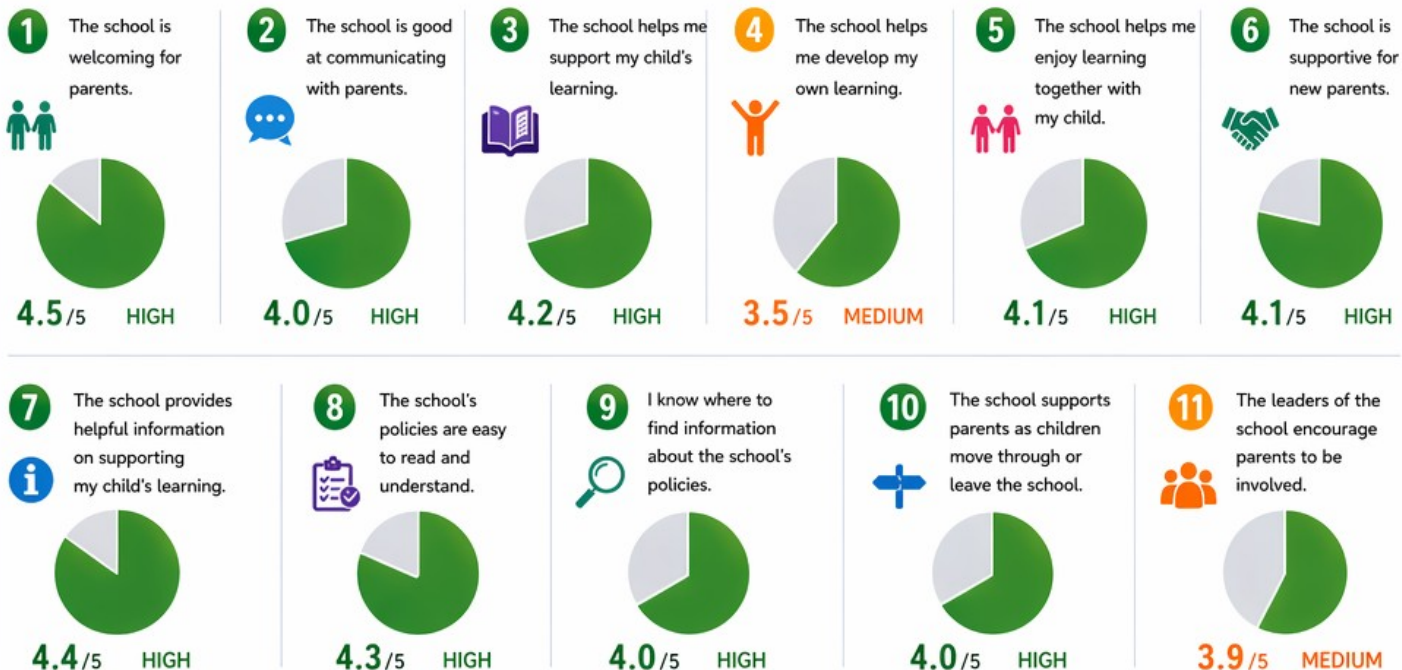
Key Issues Raised
