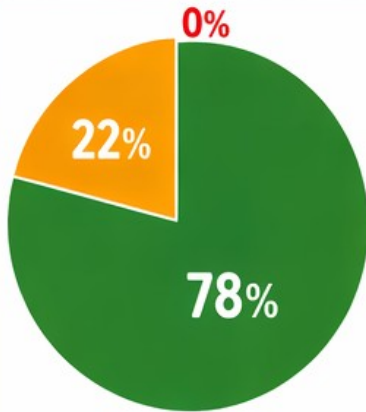

More opportunities for parents to develop their own learning and be involved in school life.



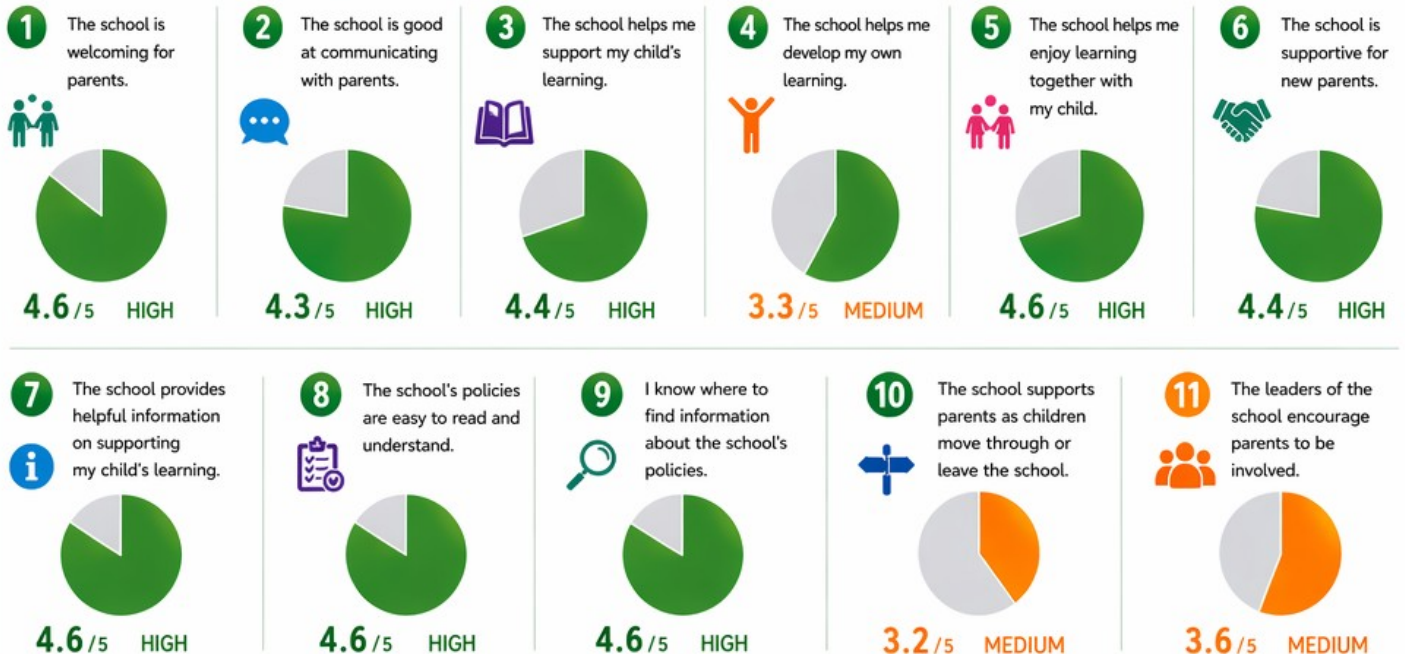
