Communication and Language

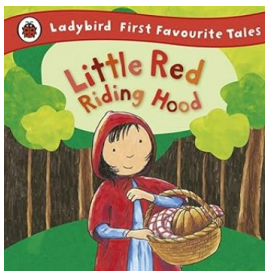
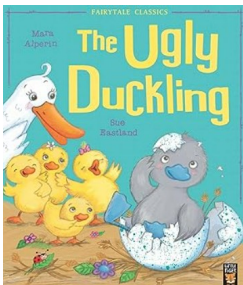
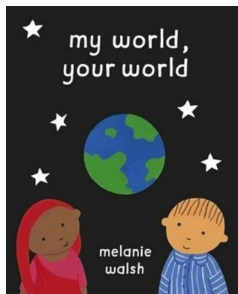
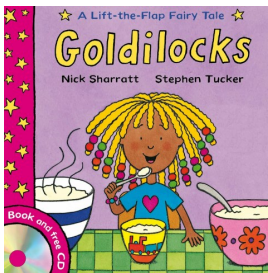
We will refine our ability to engage in to and throw conversation with our friends and teachers. We will articulate ideas and thoughts by talking in well formed sentences.

Literacy

In our writing we will continue to write words and simple phrases or sentences independently.

In our reading, we will be answering simple questions about what we have read, showing our understanding and further developing our comprehension skills.

Physical Development

In our PE sessions with Miss Baxter we will revise and refine the fundamental movement skills we have already acquired: rolling, crawling, walking, jumping, running, hopping, skipping, climbing. We develop in confidence, competence, precision and accuracy when engaging in activities that involve a ball.

In class we will be learning to refine our handwriting style to ensure it is fast, accurate

Mathematics

We work with amounts beyond 10; verbally counting beyond 20, recognising the pattern of the counting system.

We will continue to explore and represent patterns within numbers up to 10, including evens and odds, double facts, number bonds and how quantities can be distributed equally. We will focus on positional language and using this in our learning and play. We will consolidate our learning from this year– revisiting and gaps and mastering concepts.

Personal, Social, and Emotional Development

We continue to identify and moderate our own feelings socially and emotionally and think about the perspectives of others. We will be independent in managing our own needs as well as know about and be able to talk about how to manage our own overall health and wellbeing.

Understanding the World

We will enjoy celebrating Father's Day, and participating in Sports Day.

We will learn about traditional tales and fairy tales comparing them to Fairytales from around the world. We will learn about how other people live in different parts of the world comparing it to how we live here in England.
